

100 Word Plays: Oldham submission guidelines

Plays must be 100 words including stage directions.

The theme is Oldham. So be creative! You could write about the place, the people, the history, the future, whatever you want as long as you consider this theme.

Make sure you include a 'written by' credit otherwise your work will be credited as 'written by anonymous'. This line is not included in your 100 words.

The Coliseum is a public building as such we will not display any plays that contain adult content or expletives.

We will not accept plays that are in any way sexist, homophobic, transphobic, racist or discriminative toward any other protected characteristic.

Please note this is not a competition and the 100 Word Plays will not be produced for the stage by the Coliseum.

By submitting your 100 Word Play, you agree to allow the Oldham Coliseum Theatre to exhibit your script in the Coliseum and, if selected, record it for inclusion in a podcast.
