When it is safe to hold meetings in person the Coliseum will provide chips for the meet ups to boost the relaxed and welcoming atmosphere. Whilst under covid-19 restrictions the meet ups will take place virtually over Zoom, attendees are encouraged to have chips for their own enjoyment.

The first **Culture and Chips** meet up at on Wednesday 16 December at 5pm. The meet up will take place virtually via Zoom. Tickets are free but must be booked via the Coliseum website.
